

Grace Place for Children and Families Announces Seventh Annual "A Swing of Grace" Golf Outing

Naples, FL – April 5, 2018 – Grace Place for Children and Families in Golden Gate City announces that its seventh annual "A Swing of Grace" golf outing is scheduled for April 21, 2018 at Wyndemere Country Club.

The entry fee includes lunch, on-course refreshments, 18-holes of golf, golf cart rental, greens fee, range balls, and an auction and a strolling dinner following the outing.

The evening will also include a keynote address by Grace Place alumna, Eliana Tardio. Ms. Tardio will share her story of transformation from an isolated young immigrant to a confident business woman who has written three books, is the founder and owner of one of the biggest special needs blogs worldwide with more than 400 thousand subscribers, and who has spoken at the White House twice.

"A Swing of Grace" began in 2012 and is the signature fundraising event for Grace Place. One-hundred percent of the proceeds benefit Grace Place's educational programs: the nationally recognized family literacy program, Bright Beginnings, Academy of Leaders K-12 after-school program, the AP Leadership college access program and Adult Education.

In 2017, 179 golfers hit the greens at the Wyndemere Country Club, netting a phenomenal \$194,000 for the organization. The event has netted the organization more than \$700,000 in the past six years.
