

A Swing of Grace Golf Outing Raises Record-Breaking Total to Benefit Family Literacy Programs at Grace Place

NAPLES, FL – May 8, 2018- Grace Place for Children and Families held its seventh annual A Swing of Grace golf outing, raising a record-breaking net total of \$200,000, with a cost ratio of eleven percent.

Over 160 golfers from as far north as Cape Coral came out to support the organization's mission of putting faith into action, providing pathways out of poverty by educating children and families. After the golfers returned from the greens, they were joined by additional dinner guests for the evening's program, silent auction and strolling dinner.

The highlight of the outing came during the dinner program. Guests were quickly reminded of the real reason for the day's event as the key note speaker, Eliana, took the podium. The mother of two is an alumna of the Bright Beginnings family literacy program at Grace Place. Ms. Tardio shared her story of transformation from an isolated young immigrant to a confident business woman who has written three books, is the founder and owner of one of the biggest special needs blogs worldwide with more than 400 thousand subscribers, and who has spoken at the White House twice.

"I am fully independent. I own my house and my car. I pay for health insurance, invest in my education, and I love this country, my country and the country of my children. People invested in me in the times I needed it the most, and I am fully aware of that. I pay it forward by sharing my story and helping others understand the power of places like Grace Place," Ms. Tardio shared.

The audience was visibly moved by Eliana's journey, as many approached her to congratulate her on her accomplishments. "It was very important to the committee to keep the mission at the forefront of the event. We wanted the impact of their support to be felt," remarked committee chair, Erik Lutgert.
