BENEFITING GRACE PLACE FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

About Grace Place:

Grace Place is an educational touchstone for the Golden Gate community. Working to break the cycle of poverty through education, Grace Place has pioneered a family literacy program that produces enduring results.

Currently over 1,100 students are enrolled in Grace Place's three educational programs: the nationally recognized Bright Beginnings Program, School Age Programs and Adult Education. In Bright Beginnings, pre-kindergarten children learn tools essential for success in school while their parents learn to be their child's first teacher and improve their parenting and language skills. Students in our School Age Programs take advantage of academic support and peer mentoring, and high school students become empowered to attain postsecondary education and job training. Adult Education students build their English language skills, take citizenship courses, and become financially literate.

Grace Place's Food Pantry provides more than 250 families each week with basic groceries, filling gaps in nutrition for our students so they can focus on their studies, and helping to meet the basic needs of the wider Golden Gate community.

Grace Place also works extensively with community partners to provide medical and mental health screenings, and referrals for other essential services.

Grace Place is a volunteer driven organization. Of the more than 300 people who volunteer with us each year, more than 200 dedicate two to four hours of their time to our organization every week. Among them are volunteers who have themselves benefited from Grace Place's programs and return to our campus to pay our investment in them forward. With dedicated volunteers, a committed administrative staff and an exceptionally qualified teaching staff, Grace Place provides pathways out of poverty through education.
